ONE FINE DAY OF BEING A FARMER



The overdevelopment and the building of hotels and villas in the Ubud area have contributed to major water shortages. In Pejeng, just 45 minutes north of Ubud, villagers are only able to harvest rice once a year due to the limited supply of water and the ample amount of water needed to grow rice. Many NGOs have been working with the local communities in Pejeng to help them convert from rice-growing to organic permaculture. Kebun Mai is a community-driven agrotourism project that aims to spread the understanding of organic permaculture to both the local community and global visitors.

ROYAL DINNER AT THE HISTORICAL PALACE



Pejiatan Royal Palace is one of the oldest palaces in Ubud. The building was constructed in 1769 on a 3 - 4 hectare land. Adopting the traditional Balinese architecture, the Tri Mandala is the philosophical concept that is used for the building. The right hand of the prince will give us a tour around the palace and stories of the Balinese kingdom in ancient days. Then, in the end, we will have the opportunity to meet and have a discussion with the Prince himself. We will also have a Balinese royal dinner while sitting down with the prince and it's the perfect time to feed your curiosity about the royal family, deeper Balinese culture, and history!

Highlight Activities

- Use the Balinese attire to enter the Palace
- Engage and have a discussion with the palace guide by hearing about the history of Balinese kingdoms & have a tour of the palace
- Have a royal dinner hosted by the part of the royal family of the palace
- Have a light discussion while having dinner with the royal family if we are lucky we can meet with the prince.
- Enjoy the private traditional dance (Legong, Ramayana, Barong, and other dances) after dinner as a closing event.

WOMAN IN BALI, CULTURE, SOCIETY, AND DAILY LIFE



Women play a critical role in sustaining the Balinese culture. They have significant responsibilities between being a mom and working. The founder of the center, Ibu Sari created a women's center to provide local women with resources to help them meet their lifestyle demands. The center offers programs in cooking, sewing, stress management, self-esteem, public speaking, yoga, and meditation (also for men), fashion, computers, and English class (also for children). We will have the opportunity to understand social innovation from the grassroots level in Bali and how this community works to restore the balance between men and women in their society.

- Have a tour of the center Meet the children with special needs
- Do programs that the center has to offer (workshop about sewing, natural soap making, offering making, cooking class, home visit, and storytelling)

OWL VILLAGE & THEIR LOCAL WISDOM



Pagi Village is a village that is still strong in maintaining its culture and local wisdom. It is in the Tabanan area of Penebel Village. Pagi Village also has a flagship product, the red rice tea which is very healthy, and the process of making it is all organic. One other uniqueness of this village is that they have owl conservation, Tyto Alba that is rarely seen, especially In Bali anymore. These owls are also a part of their organic farming system where they can hunt for the rats and other pests. Besides that, they have a movement called UMAWALI that is created and managed by the villagers here, not only to increase their finances but also to preserve the area. And yes, we will have the tour at night!

- Visit the owl conservation
- Learn about the UMAWALI Movement



Tenganan Pegringsingan or Pageringsingan is a village in the regency of Karangasem in East Bali, Indonesia. Before the 1970s were known by anthropologists to be a secluded society in the archipelago. Tourists are attracted to Tenganan by its unique Bali Aga culture that still holds to the original traditions, ceremonies, and rules of ancient Balinese, and its unique village layout and architecture. It is known for its gamelan selunding or Gambelan selonding music played on iron metallophones and gringsing or geringsing double ikat textiles woven in only 3 places in the world

- Meet with the people and learn about their activities like basket weaving and honey farm' taste the real stingless bee honey.



ANCIENT BALI MANUSCRIPTS LESSON ON LONTAR LEAF



Pak Nyoman is one of the local heroes that still preserve an ancient way of lontar manuscript writing, his skill was passed down from his grandfather who actually a temple priest and has a collection of 90 pieces of lontar books at his house that contain a lots of knowledge from healing, astrology, herbal medicine, ritual, spiritual awakening, old chanting, storytelling, and many more. Currently, he works in a cultural department in a local government and focuses on helping a Balinese family that wanted to protect and preserve the old lontar books from spoiling. Here we will have a chance to learn about how to write on lontar and hear his unique story from some lontar and see some amazingly beautiful artwork that he's working on.

- Meet with Pak Nyoman the one who preserved the old lontar manuscripts of Bali

Until then in the year nineties, their father can't see any turtle anymore, and also some activist was coming to the area to educate the community about how bad if they caught an endangered animal such as a turtle. Because since the turtle is born in the next 25 years the turtle will lay the egg. And from 70 to 120 eggs only 1 turtle may save. Also, the danger of plastic that turtles eat in the ocean makes the turtle population in danger. But now the community already save and release more than 500 thousand baby turtles and now lots of turtles already coming back for eggs and babies.

CORAL RESTORATION PROJECT BIOROCK COMMUNITY



A long time ago the fishing community living in this area are using mall fishing like boom, poison, and illegal fishing that destroy the coral and make the fish gone. But since the community introduced the Biorock project, which help to restore the life of coral, and since a lot of fish come to the area to lay their egg and now they are plenty of fish ecosystems here. Biorock is an artificial rock created by electrolysis in seawater. The material is formed when a small electric current is passed between underwater metal electrodes placed in seawater causing dissolved minerals to accrete onto the cathode to form a thick layer of limestone and that makes the coral grow 60 times faster than the normal way.

Highlight Activities

- Meet the Biorock community led by one of the coral heroes I Ketut Danu
- Learn the story and history of the Biorock community and how they grow the coral in the area
- Learn the Biorock process and technique, and how it works to grow the coral.
- Hop on the boat and prepare yourself for snorkeling
- Explore the wide coral structure that has tons of fish and sea creatures inside

After that, we will meet with the High Priest of Bali called "Ida Pedanda" who actually takes care of lots of ceremonies in Bali and is one of the most important roles in the Balinese community. We will have a chance to get a water blessing from the High Priest and learn about Bali tradition deeply.

- Have a chance to dress up Balinese
- Meet with the traditional village leader of Pendem village "Pak Diandra"
- Learn about Balinese governance and traditional law / Adat Law
- Have lunch together with the village leader
- Meet the high priest of West Bali and learn deeply about the tradition

- Get a water blessing afterward from the high priest


